Dear friends, donors and sponsors!

Below is a brief report on OAZA's work for the first semester of 2019.

During this period, OAZA helped 42 children in 14 foster families - 1 in Vodnjan, 1 in Kastav, 3 in Zagreb, 3 in Velika Gorica, 2 in Mursko Središće, 1 in Daruvar, 1 in Pakrac, 1 in Požega, 1 in Borovo, and a family home in Petehi. This help is necessary for all fosters and family members, because what they get from the Center of social welfare is not enough for the needs of children.

We have provided financial assistance, food aid, clothes and shoes for all families and for the family home we were able to get a used 8-seat vehicle. In May, the manager visited the families that live far away, talked to the fosters and children, spent time with them, and together they discussed how to solve some problems for the foster children.

All the children who are in families progress. Most of them have already adapted, only three families have new children who are still adapting, but with commitment and patience they will gradually step in the daily life of the new family.

The children who had serious health problems on their arrival, are much better now, and with regular controls and care their health is progressing. Most children who attend school progress more and more successfully. Several young people are still in the family, even though they have already completed their schooling and have no more right to be placed through the centre of social care, but the families still takes care of them and helps them find a job and to become independent. This is the best sign that the family who cares for and loves the child is the best solution for children who are separated from their problematic families.

OAZA continues to participate actively in the work of the Network of foster Associations "Forum for quality fostering". Earlier this year, a new law was adopted, and "Forum" has given its contribution so that fostering can be carried out as a profession. Along with other associations, OAZA has an impact on improving the situation of fosters, which leads to the development of fostering and the reduction in the number of children placed in institutions; meetings of fosters, consultations and promotions for fostering are organized throughout Croatia.
